



USA Hockey NAHL Registration

Beginning the 2020-21 season, per USA Hockey, member teams are required to complete a USA Hockey registration, SafeSport training program, and USA Hockey background screen with NCSI for all billet families (including any adults or adult children living in the house), coaches, trainers, equipment personnel, general managers, owners, and volunteers that are actively involved in the management and supervision of the team.

Coaches

1. Register with USA Hockey for the 2020-21 season.
